Program description

The FLTA Program is a nine-month, fully-funded, non-degree program that provides young teachers of English an opportunity to refine their teaching skills, increase their English language proficiency while teaching basic Kiswahili to American university students and extending one's knowledge of the society and culture of the United States.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be Kenyan citizens
2. Applicants must be teachers of English or in training to become teachers of English
3. Must possess a bachelor of education (English/Literature) degree by June 1, 2018
4. Applicants must be fluent in English and TOEFL is be **mandatory**
5. Applicants should be at least 21 years old and no more than 29 years old by October 1, 2018
6. Applicants must be in good health. Successful candidates will be asked to submit a Medical History and Examination Report
