#### HIPPOCRATIC OATH

I swear by the Almighty God and all the congregation here as my witnesses, that, according to my ability and judgment, I will keep this Oath and this contract.

To hold him who taught me this art equally dear to me as my parents, to be a partner in life with him, and to fulfill his needs when required; to look upon his offspring as equal to my own siblings, and to teach them this art, if they shall wish to learn it, without fee or contact; and that by the set rules, lectures, and every other mode of instruction, I will impart a knowledge of the art to my own sons, and those of my teachers, and to students bound by this contract and having sworn this Oath to the law of medicine, but to no others.

I will use those dietary regimens which will benefit my patients according to my greatest ability and judgment, and I will do no harm or injustice to them.

I will not give a lethal drug to anyone if I am asked, nor will I advise such a plan; and similarly I will not give any patient a drug that shall cause harm.

In purity and according to divine law will I carry out my life and my art. I will not use the knife unnecessarily without supportive justification, but I will consult with those who are trained in this craft of surgery. Into whatever homes I go, I will enter them for the benefit of the sick, avoiding any voluntary act 01 impropriety or corruption, including the seduction of women or men, whether they are free men or slaves.

vVhatever I see or hear in the lives of my patients, whether in connection wit h my professional practice or not, which ought not to be spoken of outside, I will keep secret, as considering such things to be private.
